Highlights

- Includes a whole exchange year (= 3rd study year) with no extra tuition fee
- Possibility to do a double degree (French only)

- *Timeline for Registration for European Studies:*
 - 1) Online registration in late October (invitations & link will be sent to all Year 1 students that fulfil the above requirements)
 - 2) Short meeting with Programme Coordinators to choose the target language (French or German)
 - 3) All students who successfully registered will be notified in late November, and can officially start the European Studies Programme at the beginning of Semester 2 (January 2025)
