
## 副修 歴史 Minor in History








From 2009 to 2024, a total of 455 students graduated with a Minor in History. A significant rise in interest is observable over the past eight years.

「歷史」是甚麼?前人有經典的定義;我們有嶄新的理解。香港浸會大學歷史系提供的歷史科目,能與各種主修課程配合,啟發同學思維,提升分析能力,學術視野也因而得到充分擴展。在我們的心目中,歷史學為人類提供重要的生活技能與經驗,這些珍貴知識包括:

- 1. 歷史學教導我們認識「經驗」,而「經驗」帶領我們在需要抉擇的時候,作出適當判斷;
- 2. 歷史學幫助我們透徹了解人類社會,賦予生活上所需之各種知識;
- 3. 歷史學幫助同學們建立一種跨學科學術觀念,讓屬於不同專業領域內的同學在從事學 術研究時,能融會貫通各種學科的研究方法,學問因而更上層樓;
- 4. 歷史學是一種技藝,這種技藝的關鍵為處理龐雜資料及掌握各種研究方法的超卓能力。在這個資訊爆炸的年代,擁有這種能力,在職場上可謂無往不利。

我們相信,歷史學可以幫助同學們提升分析、辯證和表達能力,而這些能力在全人發展、學術追求,以至計劃前途三個個人成長範疇之中,均起關鍵作用。

What is History? History is a constantly evolving discipline; therefore, today's historians come to conclusions that differ from those of historians in the past. The Department of History provides diverse and inspirational courses that enrich students' critical thinking skills and broaden their intellectual horizons. Furthermore, studying history provides us with important life skills and experience, including:

- 1. knowledge of historical experiences that can guide our decisions in the present;
- 2. an enriched understanding of the human society in which we live;
- 3. an interdisciplinary perspective, which is of value to a variety of professions and conducive to further study in multiple areas;
- 4. the skills to conduct research and manage large amounts of information, which is an essential skill for career success in the information age.

With regard to whole-person development, academic pursuits and career planning, a minor in history provides excellent training in analytical, argumentative and communication skills.


