Undergraduate Programme

BSocSc (Hons) in Geography provides a firm foundation in geographical methodology and broadbased training in the discipline that allows students to have a balanced view of the contemporary world. Emphasis is placed on the ways in which geographers may assist in finding solutions to realworld problems.



Research Postgraduate Programmes

MPhil/PhD in Geography enables students to embrace diverse fields of study in physical and human geography, deal with debates and advance knowledge and research skills. Potential fields of study include climate change, earth systems, GIS and remote sensing applications, energy and environmental policy, urban planning, transportation and mobility, regional development, cultural and social geography, sustainability and well-being, etc.
