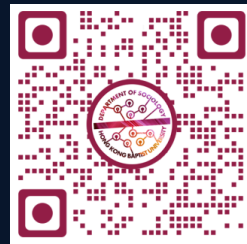

PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION

BSocSc (Hons) in Sociology programme is about studying complex relationships among individuals, groups, and larger social institutions and structures. It stresses the integration and application of theory and research, and offers thorough and rigorous training in cutting-edge digital and visual technology, as well as quantitative and qualitative data analysis.

The programme aims to provide students with (1) a comprehensive knowledge on continuities and changes in social structures and their relations with social institutions at the local, regional and global levels; (2) a critical understanding of social values and the multifaceted meanings of behaviour in different social situations; (3) critical thinking and skills adequate for academic inquiry and everyday problem-solving. The programme integrates with digital humanities, equipping students to analyze social data with generative AI and digital tools. This prepares graduates to address contemporary issues in digital era.
